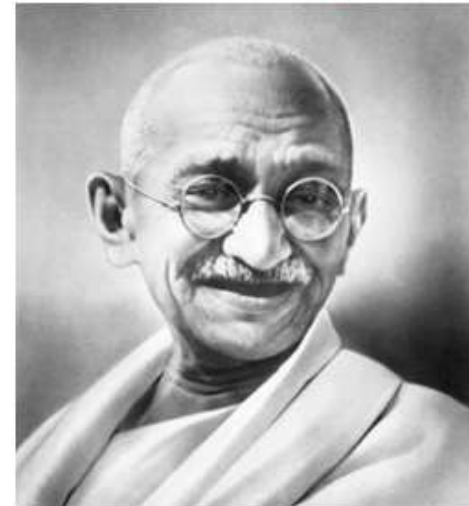
CAPIH Charitable Work

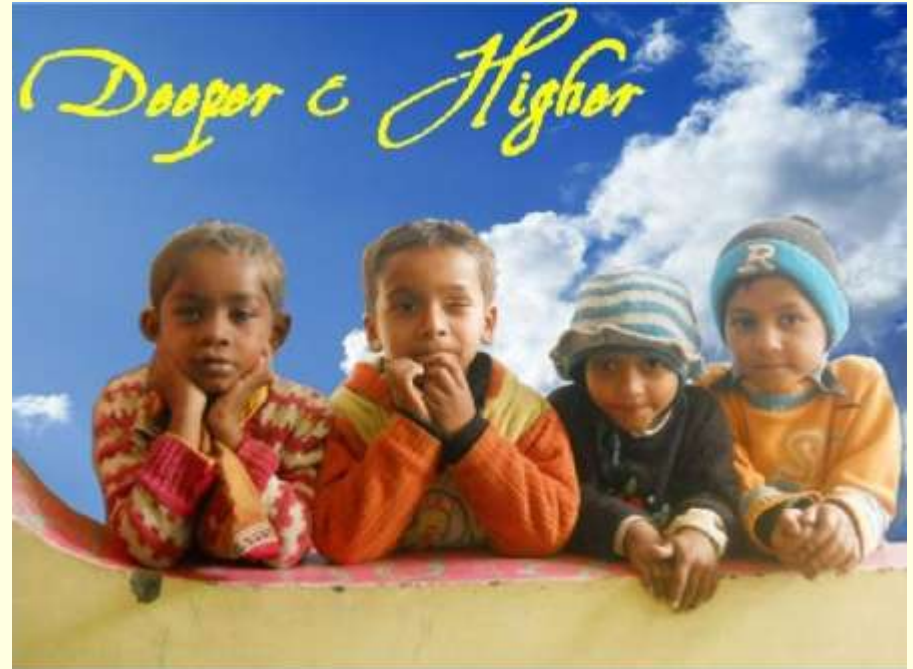
